POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

Springhurst Pool & Clubhouse is a private facility, for the exclusive use by members. Members must adhere to all posted rules and regulations. These pool regulations are set forth to ensure the safety and enjoyment of our pool members and guests. They are not meant to be all-inclusive.

The lifeguard team, gate attendant and pool supervisor have the responsibility to enforce these at all times, and their judgment is both necessary and expected. **THE LIFEGUARD TEAM, GATE ATTENDANT AND POOL SUPERVISOR ARE IN CHARGE OF THE OPERATION OF THE FACILITY AT ALL TIMES. Enforcement of the pool rules and disciplinary action is at the sole discretion of the lifeguard team, gate attendant and pool supervisor, up to and including asking members or guests to leave the facility. Should the lifeguard team, gate attendant or pool supervisor judge any activity at the pool to be unacceptable for any reason, their decision is final. Repeated issues, upon review by the SCA Pool & Clubhouse Committee, may result in suspension of member privileges, at the board's discretion.**

- A "household member" is a spouse, child or other family member whose legal residence is in the member's home. A relative or friend visiting for the summer is not a household member for purposes of pool use. Likewise, a grandparent, cousin or other extended family member who does not reside in the home is not a household member. If a resident misuses a pool card in this or any other capacity, the Board maintains the right to suspend that member's family pool privileges for the remainder of the season.
- Pool members who are age 6 or older are required to have their photo taken for pool entry validation/verification and must display and scan their membership card at the pool gate to gain admittance. Each pool member may receive up to one free replacement membership card each season. Additional replacement cards are available for \$10 each at the gate.
- Season passes are available for \$40 for Babysitters/Nannies/Exchange students age 16 and older. Passes may be used only when caring for a member's child. In addition, pool members may purchase a season pass for a child or grandchild who does not live in the household for \$40 per child/grandchild. Each Season pass will be specific to the pass holder and cannot be transferred or assigned to another person. Any guest or pass holder must be accompanied by a member of the resident's household to enter the pool. Please contact the association manager at 425-4672 to purchase these passes.
- Guests (over 12 months of age) must be accompanied by a member and have a valid guest pass. **When paid at the gate the guest fee is \$5.** *All complimentary and pre-purchased guest passes are honored without additional gate charges, with the exception that an additional \$2 will be collected only on Memorial Day holiday weekend, July 4th holiday weekend, and Labor Day holiday weekend.* Guest passes may be purchased at the pool gate – cash or member's personal check is accepted. Books of ten guest passes may be purchased at a discounted price of \$40. Passes are not transferrable or refundable and may only be utilized during the season purchased. The maximum number of guests Monday-Thursday is 7 per family and 5 on Friday, weekends and holidays. The guest attendance at the pool is subject to pool supervisor's discretion. Guest policy subject to change, with one week's posted notice.
- Children under 11 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible person of at least 16 years of age. If supervision is judged by the lifeguard team, gate attendant or pool supervisor to be inadequate to ensure the safety of the children, they will be asked to leave the facility.
- **NO GLASS OR CRYSTAL CLEAR PLASTIC CONTAINERS OF ANY TYPE ARE ALLOWED IN THE GATED POOL AREA.**
- The pool & clubhouse are non-smoking environments. Smoking is not allowed in the clubhouse or within the gated pool area.
- The gas grilling center is available for use by all members over the age of 18. Members are to sign out the grill key and user manual and maintain the grill and grill area in a neat and clean manner. The gas is to be shut off after cooking is complete.

- Coolers and food are permitted within the gated pool area, however all beverages must be in non-glass containers. Alcoholic beverages are permitted however, any person exhibiting intoxication, using unacceptable or foul language, or otherwise exhibiting inappropriate behavior shall be asked to immediately leave the facility. No food or drink is allowed in the water, and no food is allowed at the edge of the pool. **Failure to do so may result in the immediate revocation and suspension of the member's pool privileges.**
- Members are requested to police their immediate area at all times and to throw all loose trash in the receptacles provided.
- The wading pool is for use by children under the height of 36". A responsible adult must accompany the children inside the wading pool enclosure and must actively supervise children at all times while in the wading pool and enclosure.
- All children who are not toilet-trained must wear *Little Swimmers* pants or similar... **No diapers are allowed in either pool.**
- Users of the pool must be appropriately attired.
- DUE TO HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS, any vomiting, urination, defecation or diarrhea discharge needs to be immediately reported to the lifeguard team or pool supervisor so that appropriate cleaning actions can be undertaken. This includes any unintentional discharges in the pools or restroom areas.
- Use of flotation devices may be restricted at the discretion of lifeguard team or pool supervisor. Flotation devices and goggles may not be worn when jumping off the diving boards.
- Chairs and chaise lounges are for use on a first come, first served basis and are not to be saved for others not in attendance.
- The lifeguard team will apply their judgment in the areas of unacceptable items and unsafe play. Please cooperate with their instructions at all times for the safety and enjoyment of our facilities.
- If the lifeguard team, gate attendant or pool supervisor receives a **complaint of any kind** regarding music or sound, they will require the device to be turned off or listened to through headphones only.

Any operational questions or concerns should be addressed to the pool supervisor.
